For those who hadn't heard, our groundsman, Mark Savin passed away unexpectedly on Saturday 9th May.


We have passed on our condolences to his family. He was a dedicated groundsman here for 11 years. We are in the process of finding a replacement for Mark.

The **Healthy Smiles Bright Future** Program is run using best practice guidelines as set out by the Australian Dental Association.



Check-ups are scheduled to be performed at the school by local dentists whom have relevant professional training, clearances and equipment required to perform high quality dental services in a school setting.

(Please note: **MobileDentalCareSA** will be contacting parents/guardians to obtain verbal consent prior to any follow-up treatment being undertaken)





