**MASKS ARE REQUIRED**

All adults must wear a mask while indoors and in the presence of other adults at this school.  
Masks are not required while eating or drinking or while outside.  
Masks are not required for adults when teaching or engaging with students.

- Wash and dry (or sanitise) your hands before you put on your mask.
- Make sure your mask completely covers your nose, mouth and chin.
- Try not to touch, or adjust, the front of your mask while wearing it.
- Do not allow the mask to hang around your neck, or sit under your nose.
- Responsibly dispose of single-use masks in the bin. Do not put into recycling.
- Wash and dry (or sanitise) your hands after removing the mask.

Masks are not required for students or staff who have a medical condition, such as problems with their breathing, a serious skin condition on the face, a disability, or a mental health condition.

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## COVID CHECK-IN

**Reminder that it is a legal requirement that if you enter a building on site that you must sign in.** All adults (including staff and parents) entering buildings must check-in by scanning the QR code or completing the [paper recording log template](#) located in the office or in classrooms.

Children and students (including adult students) do not need to check-in. Their attendance is recorded in EDSAS, EYS, EMS etc and can be easily made available to SA Health for contact tracing purposes.

Please note the COVID Safe Check-in is purely for SA Health contact tracing purposes and doesn't replace your normal visitor sign-in process. All guests should continue to sign in at the front office/reception on arrival.

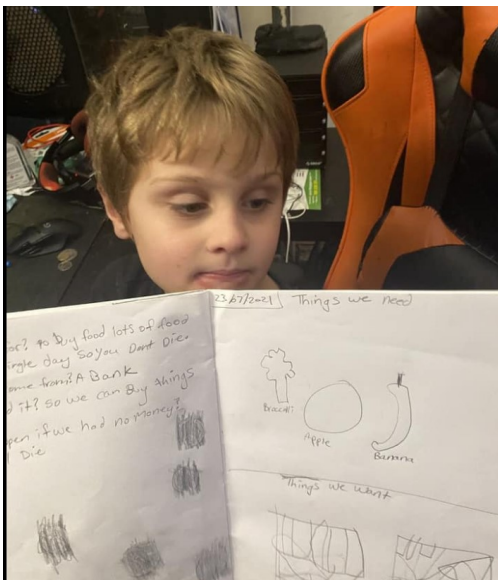
## Student Teachers

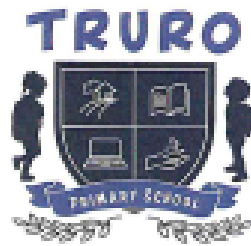

### COVID-19 Principal Update – 27<sup>th</sup> July 2021

Dear Parents/Carers,

Today the Premier announced that schools, preschools and children's centres will reopen to all students tomorrow (Wednesday 28 July).

As a result, our school **will be open**. Our Play Centre on Friday morning will also be open.

We will not be offering an alternative home-based learning program unless your child is impacted by SA Health quarantine orders.

As the Chief Public Health Officer said, just because the hard lockdown is being lifted does not mean that the risks associated with COVID-19 have passed.

Consequently, we have taken some immediate actions and steps and will monitor and review as we receive more information from SA Health and the Department for Education.

As a result, the following requirements are in place:

- Wherever possible, please drop and collect your child at the gate and maintain the appropriate physical distance from other adults. If you need to enter the school grounds you will need to wear a mask and do the covid check-in, we have masks available at the office if needed when entering.
- Use online platforms (Class Dojo, emails, Skoolbag, Facebook) or phones to contact teachers or the front office wherever possible.
- All staff are required to wear masks when indoors, on public transport or on school buses unless they have a medical exemption. Please note that staff will not have to wear masks while teaching or working directly with students and students in primary schools are also exempt from wearing masks at school.
- Parents attending Play Centre on Friday morning will need to wear a mask and remember to maintain physical distance from other adults.

Thank you very much for your support during the lockdown. We look forward to having your child back at school tomorrow.
